Aishton	Thomas, Dr.	of Bath, father of Miss Maria, who married Robert McCoy of Fredericksburgh, Oct. 3, 1859
Akey	Paul	married Miss Barbara McCoy, both of Hungerford, Apr. 21, 1851
Albertson	Mrs.	of Loughborough, fell dead while preparing to go to a camp meeting, July 2, 1858

Alexander	David Jr.	late of Kingston, died at Toronto, aged 24 years, Feb. 6, 1859
Alfin	John	of Kingston, married Miss Mary Barrett of Ernestown, May 24, 1847
Alkenbrack	George	married Miss Ann Williamson, both of Camden, by Rev. C. Fish, July 14, 1855
Allen	Eunice	married George Clark, Dec. 16, 1834
Allen	James, Mrs.	married the previous winter, took sick with measles and cold and never recovered her health, died, Oct. 11, 1851
Allen	Lewis	of Elizabethtown, guest of John C. Clark, Nov. 17, 1834
Allen	Miss	visited with Miss Curtis at John C. Clark's, Aug. 11, 1834
Allen	Mr.	lost his large house on Brock Street, Kingston, to fire, Feb. 1, 1849
Allen	William	known as "Big Bill Allen", of near Odessa, died after 12 hours of sickness, Aug. 26, 1857
Allen	William	married Miss Mary Ann Conley, both of Kingston, by Rev. Machar, Feb. 25, 1858
Allison	Cyrus R., Rev.	preached in school house, June 30, 1844
Allison	Cyrus R., Rev.	married Peregrine M. Clark to Eleanor Jane Smith, Oct. 28, 1844
Allison	Cyrus R., Rev.	married Archibald John Garbutt to Eliza Jane Clark, Nov. 7, 1844
