

At a Court of Oyer and Terminer and General Gaol Delivery for the Western District held at Sandwich courthouse, on the fifth day of September, 1803

Court met at 7 o'clock. The Commission read. The sheriff returned the Precept. The Grand Jury called and sworn as follows:
